ORDINANCE No. 266

AN ORBINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE, DELIVERY OR GIVING AWAY OF ANY INTOXICATING LIQUOR, BEER OR WINE TO PERSONS UNDER THE AGEN OF TWENTY ONE YEARS (21) & ND MAKING ANY PERSON UNDER TWENTY-ONE (21) WHO MIS-REPRESENTS HIS OR HER AGE FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING INTOXICATING LIQUOR, BEER OR WINE GUILTY OF a misdemeanor; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE No. 267

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY ELECTIVE AND APPOINTIVE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NUMBER 250 and 251, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

SECTION I: That the salabies of the following elective officers are hereby fixed as follows:

The salary of the Mayor; \$25.00 p r month.

The salary of each alderman; \$15.00 per month

The salary of the City Treasurer; \$95.00 per month.

The salary of the Police Judg; \$50.00 per month.
