

## RESOLUTION NO. 182

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF 3RD. STREET EAST BETWEEN A POINT 100 FEET NORTH OF 10TH AVENUE EAST AND THE SOUTH BOUNDARY LINE OF 11TH AVENUE EAST. ALL OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK SIX (6) AND THE SOUTH 100 FEET OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK THREE (3); AND TENTH AVENUE EAST BETWEEN SECOND STREET EAST AND THE ALLEY IN BLOCK TWO (2); ALL IN POLSON CITY CENTER ADDITION TO THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

WHEREAS, the City of Polson, Montana is the owner of Blocks Six (6) and Seven (7); and Lots Twenty-two (22) thru Twenty-nine (29) inclusive, of Block Three (3); and Lots Twenty-two (22) thru Twenty-nine inclusive, of Block Two (2), all in City Center Addition to the City of Polson, Montana, which blocks are separated by 3rd Street East and 10th Avenue East, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the said City Council to develop both of said Blocks and said lots as a recreational area, and to do so would require the vacation of Third Street East between a point 100 feet north of 10th Avenue East and the south boundary line of Eleventh Avenue East; and all of the alley in Block Six (6) and the south 100 feet of the alley in Block Three (3); and 10th Avenue East between 2nd. Street East and the Alley in Block Two (2), all in City Center Addition to the City of Polson, Montana, and

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of September, 1961, the said City Council did pass, and the Mayor did approve, a Resolution declaring its intention to vacate said public thoroughfares, for the reasons therein, and herein, stated; and directing the City Clerk that notice be published or posted in three (3) public places stating that the final determination of the abandonment of said street, avenue, and alley will be held on the 2nd day of October, 1961, at the City Hall, in the City of Polson, Montana, when and where any persons interested may appear and be heard for or against the abandonment of said street, avenue and alley, and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk did give notice of said hearing, as required by law, by causing the same to be published in September 21st. and 28th issues of the FLATHEAD COURIER, a weekly newspaper of general circulation in the City of Polson, Montana, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing, for the final determination of the abandonment of said public thoroughfares, was held at the City Hall, in the City of Polson, Montana, on October 2nd, 1961, as hereinbefore provided, at which hearing all interested persons were given full opportunity to be heard for or against the abandonment of said public thoroughfares, and

WHEREAS, after full hearing and due consideration, it appears to the Mayor and Council of the said City of Polson, Montana, that it is to the best interest of the said City of Polson, Montana, and of the people thereof, that the said public thoroughfares be vacated,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Polson, Montana, that 3rd. Street East between a point 100 feet north of 10th. Avenue East and the south boundary line of 11th. Avenue East; all of the alley in Block Six (6) and the south 100 feet of the alley in Block Three (3); and 10th Avenue East between 2nd. Street East and the alley in Block Two (2); all in Polson City Center Addition to the City of Polson, Montana, shall be, and hereby are, vacated and discontinued.
