## (Same) 3 RESOLUTION NO. 184

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANZ PROVIDING FOR VACATING, ABANDONING AND CLOSING OF THAT PART OF FIRST STREET WEST BETWEEN THE SOUTH LINE OF EIGHTH AVENUE AND THE NORTH LINE OF ELEVENTH AVENUE; AND THOSE PARTS OF NINTH AVENUE, TENTH AVENUE, AND THE ALLEYS IN BLOCKS NUMBERED THREE (3), FOUR (4), SEVEN (7), EIGHT (8), NINE (9), AND TEN (10), ALL TO BE CLOSED FROM THE WEST LINE OF SECOND STREET WEST TO THE WEST LINE, OF LOTS NUMBERED FOUR (4), AND NINE (9) IN BLOCKS NUMBERED FOUR (4), SEVEN (7), AND TEN (10) RESPECTIVELY, ALL IN CENTRAL ADDITION TO THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, A DISTANCE OF SIX-HUNDRED-THIRTY FEET (630 ft) MORE OR LESS, SUCH CLOSURE BEING SUBJECT ONLY TO THE RIGHTS OF EXISTING PUBLIC UTILITIES.

WHEREAS, School District Number twenty-three, of Lake County, Montana is the sole owner of all of the Blocks numbered Three (3), Eight (8(, and nine (9), and Lots numbered Four (4), thru (9) inclusive in each of the Blocks numbered Four (4), Seven (7), and ten (10), all in Central Addition to the City of  $P_0$ lson, Montana, and

WHEREAS, it is the intention and desire of the School Board of said School District Number twenty-three to develope all of said lots and Blocks for purposes of a school and necessary appurtenances thereto, and

WHEREAS, the said School Board of said School District Number twenty-three deems it necessary that certain public thorofares, herein set out and defined, be vacated, abandoned and closed to public traffic in order to accomplish said purpose of a school, and has notified the City Council in writing, and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the closing of the said public thorofares is necessary and in the best interest of the public, and

WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intention to close said public thorofares was duly passed by the City Council on the 7th day of May, 1962, and approved by the Mayor, and

WHEREAS, Notice of said Resolution of Intention did specify that a hearing upon said Resolution would be held at the City Hall, at 7:30 p.m., on Monday, May 21st, 1962, at which time and place, any interested person would be heard either for or against said Resolution, and said Notice was duly published in the Flathead Courier, a newspaper of general Circulation in the City of Polson, as provided by law, and

WHEREAS, a hearing was had upon said Resolution, at said time and place, no person appearing for or against said Resolution

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, THAT: The following described public thorofares in the City of Polson, should be, and hereby are, vacated, abandoned, and closed to public traffic, subject only to rights of existing public utilities, all in the best interests of the public:

First Street West between the south line of eighth Avenue and the north line of Eleventh Avenue; and those parts Ninth Avenue, Tenth Avenue, and the alleys in blocks numbered Three (3), Four (4), Seven (7), Eight (8) Nine (9), and Ten (10), all to be closed from the west line of Second Street West to the East line of Lots numbered Four (4), and Nine (9) in Blocks numbered Four (4), Seven (7(, and Ten (10) respectively, all in Central Addition to the City of Polson, Montana, a distance of Six-hundred-thirty feet (360 ft.) more or less.
