RESOLUTION NO. 191

A RESOLUTION PROPOSING TO EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, SO AS TO INCLUDE THOSE CERTAIN TRACTS OF PARCELS OF LAND HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, WHICH ARE CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

WHEREAS, it appears to the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, it will be to the best interests of the City of Polson, Montana, and the inhabitants thereof and of all of the inhabitants of the said territory or parcels of land, as aforesaid, that the boundaries of the City of Polson, Montana, shall be extended so as to include the same within the corporate limits thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, that it is the judgment of said Council that it will be to the best interests of the City of Polson, Montana, and the inhabitants thereof and of the inhabitants of said territory or parcels of land, as aforesaid, and hereinafter described that the boundaries of the said City of polson be extended so as to include within the corporate limits of said City, the following described tracts of land, contiguous to the City of Polson, Montana:

A tract of land located in Section Three (3), Township Twenty-two (22) North, Range Twenty (20) West, Lake County, Montana, more particularly described as follows?
