

RESOLUTION NO. 196

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY DOG POUND AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SALARY OF THE CITY POUND MASTER.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, That:

WHEREAS; An immediate public emergency exists, because of the fact that at the time of the adoption for the fiscal year, 1962-1963, insufficient provisions were made for the maintenance of the City Dog Pound and payment of the salary of the City Pound Master; and,

WHEREAS; It is necessary for the immediate preservation of order and public peace to employ a City Pound Master, maintain the City Dog Pound and provide for the enforcement of the City Dog Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS; There are not sufficient funds in the General Fund to meet the emergency and to enforce said Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That emergency warrants in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars be issued against the General Fund for the purpose of paying for the maintenance of said City Dog Pound, the payment of the Pound Master and the enforcement of the Dog Ordinance; and, that a public hearing be held on the final adoption of this RESOLUTION as provided by law.
