

RESOLUTION NO. 207.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON. MONTANA. FAVORING MONTANA STATE LEGISLATURE ENACTMENT OF A LAW TAXING FUNDS SPENT ON ALL BOTTLES AND CANS CONTAINING DRINK.

WHEREAS. it appears to the City Council of the City of Polson. Montana. that a great deal of time and money is being expended by cities throughout the state in an effort to keep cans and bottles off the city streets and alleys and

WHEREAS. it appears to the City Council that such expense and time is expended solely for the benefit of those who use such cans and bottles.

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Polson. Montana. that they favor legislative enactment which would place a one cent tax on all bottles and cans containing drinks. that the proceeds are to be used to redeem the bottles and cans for one cent for each can or bottle returned to the proper authority.

The foregoing resolution was duly and regularly passed by the City Council of the City of Polson. Montana. and adopted and approved by the Mayor of the City of Polson this 15th day of June. 1964.
