

RESOLUTION NO. 208.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA. CITY COUNCIL DECLARING ITS INTENTION OF CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING THAT PART OF FOURTH STREET BETWEEN SEVENTH AVENUE TO THE ALLEY BETWEEN SIXTH AVENUE EAST AND SEVENTH AVENUE EAST. SUBJECT ONLY TO RIGHTS OF EXISTING PUBLIC UTILITIES.

WHEREAS. Flathead Irrigation Project by its agent Al Sept has informed the City Council that it and Neil Devlin are the sole owners of all the land adjoining fourth street between sixth and seventh avenues East, in the City of Polson, Montana. and

WHEREAS. it is the desire and intention of the said Flathead Irrigation Project with the consent and approval of Neil Devlin to develop the part of fourth street above referred to as an extension of the electrical facilities and necessary appurtenances thereto. and

WHEREAS. the Flathead Irrigation Project deems it necessary that the portion of fourth street referred to above be vacated and abandoned and closed to public traffic in order to accomplish said purpose. and has so notified the City Council in writing and


WHEREAS. the City Council believes that the closing of said public thoroughfares is in the public interest. and

WHEREAS. the statutes of the State of Montana requires that notice be given.

NOW THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA. that. it is the intention of the said City Council that the following described public thoroughfare be vacated, abandoned, and closed to public traffic. subject only to the rights of existing public utilities: Fourth Street East between Seventh Avenue East to the alley between Sixth Avenue East and Seventh Avenue East. all in the City of Polson, Montana. and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a notice be published or posted in three public places stating that the final determination of the abandonment of said street will be held on the 3rd day of August, 1964. at 7:30 P.M. at the City Hall in the City of Polson, Montana when and where any persons interested may appear and be heard for or against the abandonment of said street. and the City Clerk is hereby directed to give such notice as required by law.
