

RESOLUTION NO. 214.

A A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION UNDER THE GENERAL FUND TO BE USED FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION FOR THE CITY OF POLSON.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA,
 WHEREAS; An immediate public emergency exists, because of various expenditures which could not have reasonably been foreseen at the time of making the annual budget;

WHEREAS; It is necessary for the immediate preservation of order and general maintenance for the City of Polson to expend additional funds, and

WHEREAS; There are not sufficient funds in the general fund under Maintenance and Operation to meet the current need and existing emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That warrants in the amount of Three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00) Dollars be issued and registered an necessary against the General Fund for the purpose of paying for maintenance and Operation of the City of Polson; and

That, a public hearing be held on the final adoption of this Resolution as provided by law on June 7, 1965, after publication of notice one week in the Flathead Courier, the weekly newspaper in the City of Polson, County of Lake, State of Mont.
