RESOLUTION NO. 289

A RESOLUTION ORDERING THE TRANSFER OF MONIES FROM THE WATER FUND CAPITAL OUTLAY ACCOUNT AND TRANSFER BUDGET TO THE WATER FUND MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, there presently exists an impending deficit in the Maintenance and Operation Budget of the Water fund in the sum of Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100ths Dollars (7,250.00), and;

WHEREAS, there presently exists a probable excess in the Capital outlay Budget of the Water Fund in the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and 00/100ths Dollars (\$2,750.00), and;

WHEREAS, there presently exists untransferred monies in the Transfer Budget of the Water Fund in the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100ths Dollars (4,500.00),

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Polson, Montana, as follows::

It is hereby ordered, and this does order, that the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and 00/100ths Dollars (\$2,750.00) shall be transferred from the Capital Outlay Budget of the Water Fund, and that the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100ths Dollars (\$4,500.00) be transferred from the Transfer Budget of the Water Fund, totaling Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100ths Dollars (\$7,250.00) to the Maintenance and Operation Budget of the Water Fund.
