

## RESOLUTION NO. 292

A RESOLUTION CREATING AN EMERGENCY BUDGET PURSUANT TO REVISED CODES OF MANTANA, 1947, SECTION 11-1409 FOR THE POUNDMASTER, CALLING FOR THE TRANSFER OF MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE POUNDMASTER, AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, a public emergency exists which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the city budget for the City of Polson, Montana, and:

WHEREAS, the poundmaster fund is insufficient for current needs and thus a public emergency exists, and;

WHEREAS, it is estimated that Three Hundred and 00/100ths Dollars (\$300.00) will be required to meet the emergency existing in the Poundmaster Fund, and;

WHEREAS, the fund against which emergency warrants shall be drawn is the General Fund of the City of Polson, Montana, and;

WHEREAS, a public hearing will be held on the creation of said emergency budget on Monday, April 20, 1970, at the hour of 8:00 at the City Hall of the City of Polson, Montana, Notice of said hearing to be published in the Flathead Courier on Thursday, April 9, 1970.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana;

That a public emergency exists in that there are insufficient funds for the operation of the poundmaster Department of the City of Polson, Montana, and it is necessary to create an emergency budget in the amount of Three Hundred and 00/100ths Dollars (\$300.00) for the continuing operation of said department during the budget year 1970, said emergency warrants to be drawn against the General Fund of the City of Polson, Montana.

Be it further resolved that a public hearing will be held of the question of creating the said emergency budget at 8:00 P.M. on April 20, 1970, at the City Hall of the City of Polson, Montana.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this Resolution be published in the Flathead Courier on the 9th day of April, 1970.
