RESOLUTION NO. 305

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, VACATING THAT STREET COMMONLY KNOWN AND REFERRED TO AS "RIVER DRIVE", BEING AN EXTENSION OF FIFTH AVENUE WEST AND LYING BETWEEN FOURTH STREET WEST AND SIXTH STREET WEST..

WHEREAS, the City of Polson did, on the 21st day of September, 1970, after due and legal notice was given therefor, hold a public hearing relative to the Petition of the owners of all the real property abutting that street commonly known and referred to as "River Drive", being an extension of Fifth Avenue West and lying between Fourth Street West and Sixth Street West, and no protests being filed or heard against the said Petition to vacate the said street, and
