RESOLUTION NO. 314

A RESOLUTION BREATING AN EMERGENCY BUDGET PURSUANT TO REVISED CODES OF MONTANA, 1947, SECTION 11-1409, FOR THE POLICE FUND, CALLING FOR THE TRANSFER OF MONIES FROM THE BEER TAX FUND TO THE MAINTEN ANCE AND OPERATION DEPARTMENT OF THE POLICE FUND.

WHEREAS, a public emergency exists which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the City budget for the CITY of Polson, Montana, and;

WHEREAS, the Maintenance and Operation Department of the Police Fund has insufficient monies for current needs and thus a public emergency rexists, and;

WHEREAS, it is extimated that One Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100ths Dollars (\$1,500.00) will be required to meet the emergency existing in the Mainenance and Operation Department of the Police Fund, and;

WHEREAS, the fund against which emergency warrants shall be drawn is the Beer Tax Fund of the City of Polson, Montana, and;

WHEREAS, a public hearing will be held on the creations of said emergency budget on Monday, May 3, 1971, at the hour of 8:00 P. M. at the City Hall of the City of Polson, Montana, Notice of said hearing to be published in the Flathead Courier on Thursday, April 15, 1971.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana:

That a public emergency exists in that there are insufficient funds for the operation of the Maintenance and Operation Department of the Police Fund of the City of Polson, Montana, and it is necessary to create an emergency budget in the amount of the Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100th Dollars (\$1,500.00) for the continuing operation of said department during the budget year of 1971, said emergency warrants to be drawn against the Beer Tax Fund of the City of Polson, Montana.

Be it further resolved that a public hearing will be held on the question of creating the said emergency budget at 8:00 P. M. on May 3, 1971, at the City Hall of the City of Polson, Montana.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this Resolution be published in the Flathead Courier on the 15th day of April, 1971.
