

RESOLUTION NO. 326

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING ALL-PURPOSE LEVY AS A METHOD OF FINANCING CITY OF POLSON FOR ENSUING FISCAL YEAR.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, that the all-purpose levy authorized by the Revised Codes of Montana, 1947, Section 4701.1 be, and the same hereby is, adopted as the method of financing the City of Polson, Montana, for the ensuing fiscal year.

RESOLUTION NO. 327

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING REVENUE WHICH MAY BE PROVIDED IN AN UNDERTERMINED AMOUNT UNDER HR 14370, AN ACT ENTITLED STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1972.

WHEREAS, the United States Government has informed the cities and towns of Montana that the State and Local Fiscal Assistance Act of 1972 (HR 14370) may become law, and:

WHEREAS, there is contained in said law the provisions for expenditures by the local government of revenues to be allocated to each city or town, and;

WHEREAS, the city or town of Polson, Montana is required to budget for expenditures, and;

WHEREAS, the total appropriation to the city or town of Polson, Montana for the fiscal year of 1972 -1973, under the HR 14370 is not available,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the city or town of Polson, Montana appropriates the HR 14370 revenue to be expended under the provisions of the act for the following purposes to-wit:

- (1) Maintenance and operating expenses for
  - (A) public safety (including law enforcement, fire protection, and building code enforcement).
  - (B) environmental protection (including sewage disposal, sanitation and pollution abatement) and
  - (C) public transportation (including transit systems and streets), and
