

RESOLUTION NUMBER 358

A RESOLUTION ASSURING THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT THAT THE CITY OF POLSON APPROVES ALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO ENCOURAGE CONSTRUCTION AND REHABILITATION OF HOUSING LOCATED WITHIN THE POLITICAL JURISDICTION FOR HOUSEHOLDS IN NEED OF HOUSING ASSISTANCE, VESTING THE CITY COUNTY PLANNING BOARD WITH THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF COORDINATING THE ACTIONS OF PRIVATE HOUSING DEVELOPERS AND THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT TO ASSURE THAT SUCH DEVELOPMENT OR REHABILITATION IS IN THE INTEREST OF THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND GENERAL WELFARE OF THE COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that certain individuals of POLSON are in need and qualify for housing assistance; and

WHEREAS, relief is available for these individuals from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, under Title II of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, which provides for a housing assistance payment plan referred to as the Section 8 Housing Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the Section 8 Housing Assistance Program will be implemented in POLSON by legal contract between private housing developers and the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the City of POLSON is in no way obligated or required to provide financial or administrative assistance for implementation of the Section 8 program; and

WHEREAS, the City of POLSON believes that provision of rent subsidy assisted housing construction and rehabilitation for those in need is in the best interest of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of POLSON Montana;

Assures the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development that the construction and rehabilitation of rent subsidy assisted housing is in the interest of the general welfare of the community of POLSON and endorses implementation of such programs.
