

RESOLUTION NO. 384

A RESOLUTION FOR THE REFUNDING OF A PORTION OF ASSESSMENTS HERETOFORE PAID BY FOLEY, LeBRUN, ROBERTS, KENNEALLY, STEVENS, AND MAJOR ENTERPRISES, INCORPORATED.

WHEREAS, a special fund was created in January of 1977 by the City Treasurer of the City of Polson for the purpose of receiving assessments by deposit for use in the construction of a new city sewer line to service the properties beginning at Richwine's Burger-ville and extending to and including Cherry Hill Motel; and

WHEREAS, the amount of said assessments were based on an estimate of the cost of construction of said sewer line; and

WHEREAS, it was understood and agreed by and between the City of Polson and the following property owners
