A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, TO ABOLISH THE HOLDING OF A PRIMARY ELECTION FOR THE YEAR 1981.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Montana provides in MCA 13-14-115(3) and MCA 13-14-115(3)(c), respectively, that:

"In a political subdivision with a population of 10,000 or less, the governing body may determine that a primary need not be held if:

"the governing body passes a resolution not more than 7 days after the close of filing by candidates for election stating that a primary election need not be held," and

WHEREAS, the City of Polson is desirous of abolishing the holding of a primary election for the year 1981, and

WHEREAS, the closing date to file for election is July 27, 1981, and

WHEREAS, to comply with the provisions of MCA 13-14-115(3)(c), said resolution must be passed no later than August 3, 1981, to lawfully abolish said primary election for the year 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, that Resolution No. 414 be passed and approved this date in compliance with the laws of the State of Montana, specifically, MCA 13-14-115(3)(c), to abolish the holding of a primary election for the year 1981 in the City of Polson.
