RESOLUTION NO. 415

A RESOLUTION ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF CURB AND GUTTERS AND ALLEY APPROACH AND FURTHER CREATING A SPECIAL CURB AND GUTTER AND ALLEY APPROACH FUND.

WHEREAS, certain lot owners of lots bordering on the first and second blocks of First Street West have petitioned the City of Polson to create a special fund to construct curb and gutters and alley approach on the east and west sides of Blocks 1 and 2 of Central Addition, and

WHEREAS, the public convenience and safety requires and the City Council has deemed it necessary to order the construction of curb and gutters and alley approach in front of said above-mentioned lots within the City of Polson, Montana, and

WHEREAS, some of the owners of the above-mentioned property are prepared to pay for the improvements on installment basis, and

WHEREAS, it has therefore become necessary to create a special curb and gutter and alley approach fund from which to pay for the construction of the curb and gutter and alley approach on the properties belonging to the owners who wish to pay on the installment plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Polson, Montana, that:

- 1. It is hereby ordered that curb and gutters and alley approach be constructed on First Street West on the east side of Block 1 and the west side of Block 2 of the Central Addition in front of the following described properties on First Street West:
 - A. The Baptist Church First GARBC property described as Lot 1, Block 2 and Lot 6 of Block 1, Central Addition
 - B. The Jon D. Fisher property described as Lot 16, Block 2, Central Addition, and
 - C. The Raymond P. Bick property described as Lot 7, Block 1, Central Addition.
- A special curb and gutter and alley approach fund be and the same hereby is created for the following purposes:
 - A. To account for monies received through special assessments against the properties hereinabove described, and
 - B. For the purpose of paying for the work heretofore done in connection with a construction of curb and gutters and alley approach across that portion of the project where the owners desire to pay for said improvements under an installment plan.
