

RESOLUTION NO. 435

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, TO ABOLISH THE HOLDING OF A PRIMARY ELECTION FOR THE YEAR 1983.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Montana provides in M.C.A. 13-14-115(3) and M.C.A. 13-14-115(3)(c), respectively, that:

"In a political subdivision with a population of 10,000 or less, the governing body may determine that a primary need not be held if:

"the governing body passes a resolution not more than 7 days after the close of filing by candidates for election stating that a primary election need not be held," and

WHEREAS, the City of Polson is desirous of abolishing the holding of a primary election for the year 1983, and

WHEREAS, the closing date to file for election is July 25th, 1983; and

WHEREAS, to comply with the provisions of M.C.A. 13-14-115(3)(c), said resolution must be passed no later than August 1, 1983, to lawfully abolish said primary election for the year 1983.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, that Resolution No. 435 be passed and approved this date in compliance with the laws of the State of Montana, specifically, M.C.A. 13-14-115(3)(c), to abolish the holding of a primary election for the year 1983 in the City of Polson.
