

## RESOLUTION NO. 455

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, SO AS TO INCLUDE THOSE CERTAIN TRACTS OR PARCELS OF LAND HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, WHICH LAND IS CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, on the 1st day of July, 1985, duly and regularly passed and adopted a resolution declaring it to be to the best interests of the City of Polson, Montana, and of the inhabitants of the hereinafter described tract of land that the boundaries of the said City be extended to include within the corporate limits of the City of Polson, Montana, the said tract of land under the following conditions, to-wit:

1. That property owners agree to connect, at their expense, at such time that they desire, to the City water and sewer mains in accordance with specifications set out by the City of Polson, and if necessary, extend at their expense the water and sewer mains to their property boundary.
2. That property owners agree to maintain all private improvements and City agrees to maintain existing dedicated public roads. Additionally, property owners shall be obligated for the construction of all other public improvements for which the City will offer the use of the special improvement district alternative.
3. That property owners agree to remain under Rural Fire District protection until such time property owners complete necessary improvements to bring the same into the City Fire District.
4. That property owners agree to designation of the above-described property as included within a R-1 Residential zoning district and shown on the official map of that property annexed to the City of Polson.

WHEREAS, the Petition having been filed by the owner of the property described below requesting the City of Polson to annex said property under the above-mentioned conditions, which Petition waives the right of said owner to receive any and all notices, and further, waiving publication of notices, and the City Council, after due consideration, deems it for the best interests of said City and the inhabitants thereof and the inhabitants of the hereinafter described contiguous tract of land that the boundaries of the City of Polson, Montana, should be extended so as to include the hereinafter described tract of land within the corporate limits thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the boundaries of the City of Polson, Montana, shall be extended so as to include the property described as follows:

Lot Nine (9), Seifert Tracts, according to the official map or plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder, Lake County, Montana

under the following conditions, to-wit:

1. That property owners agree to connect, at their expense, at such time that they desire, to the City water and sewer mains in accordance with specifications set out by the City of Polson, and if necessary, extend at their expense the water and sewer mains to their property boundary.
2. That property owners agree to maintain all private improvements and City agrees to maintain existing dedicated public roads. Additionally, property owners shall be obligated for the construction of all other public improvements for which the City will offer the use of the special improvement district alternative.

3. That property owners agree to remain under Rural Fire District protection until such time property owners complete necessary improvements to bring the same into the City Fire District.
4. That property owners agree to designation of the above-described property as included within a R-1 Residential zoning district and shown on the official map of that property annexed to the City of Polson.

This Resolution shall take effect on the 17th day of July, 1985.
