RESOLUTION NO. 479

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, TO ABOLISH THE HOLDING OF A PRIMARY ELECTION FOR THE YEAR 1987.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Montana provides in M.C.A. 13-14-115 (3)(c), respectively, that:

"In a political subdivision with a population of 10,000 or less, the governing body may determine that a primary need not be held if:

"the governing body passes a resolution not more than 7 days after the close of filing by candidates for election stating that a primary election need not be held."

WHEREAS, the City of Polson is desirous of abolishing the holding of a primary election for the year 1987, and

WHEREAS, the closing date to file for election is July 2, 1987, and

WHEREAS, to comply with the provisions of M.C.A. 13-14-115 (3)(c) said resolution must be passed no later than July 9, 1987, to lawfully abolish said primary election for the year 1987.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, that Resolution No. 479 be passed and approved this date to comply with the laws of the State of Montana, specifically, M.C.A. 13-14-115 (3)(c), to abolish the holding of a primary election for the year 1987 in the City of Polson.
