A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE FRIDAY AFTER THANKSGIVING AS HERITAGE DAY AND DESIGNATING THE SAME AS A LEGAL HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, the 1987 Legislature adopted a bill combining Lincoln's and Washington's Birthdays into President's Day and created Heritage Day which can be observed at any time selected by the governing bodies of Montana cities and towns; and

WHEREAS, a poll has been conducted to determine what day of the year the employees of the City of Polson desire to be observed as Heritage Day, and

WHEREAS, the results of the poll indicated the majority of employees would prefer the Friday after Thanksgiving Day as Heritage Day.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Polson that the Friday after Thanksgiving Day be proclaimed as Heritage Day to be observed as a general holiday.
