

RESOLUTION 517

SUPPORTING A MISSION VALLEY FAMILY CENTER

WHEREAS, a need exists in Lake County for year around activities; and

WHEREAS, a group has formed to organize and create the Mission Valley Family Center; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the center is to provide activities for youth, adults, seniors and the physically disabled throughout the county with the following goals:

TO CREATE an umbrella organization which coordinates activities of established programs and new programs, and directs these programs with a common and consistent philosophy;

TO PROVIDE facilities and locations for families, individuals, and groups to meet for recreation, education, and the general exchange of common interests;

TO PROMOTE year-round involvement and participation in activities which involve the betterment of the physical and mental well being of the individual and the community;

TO PROMOTE interracial and intergenerational exchange between members of families, programs, and communities;

TO COORDINATE with existing programs and to create new programs which provide counseling and prevention activities for teens, mentally disabled, and drug and alcohol disease patients;

TO RELIEVE overburdened school facilities and provide post classroom activity locations for children and young adults;

TO PROMOTE volunteerism and provide a clearinghouse for programs which allow methods for individuals to express themselves in a positive manner; and


TO DEVISE appropriate means of obtaining finances for a prolonged YMCA in the Mission Valley area.
