

RESOLUTION NO. 542

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, TO EFFECTUATE A TWELVE PERCENT (12%) INCREASE IN THE CURRENT WATER, INCLUDING MINIMUM AND CONNECTING CHARGES.

WHEREAS, it is required by State law that the rates and charges for the services and facilities of the municipal water shall be sufficient to provide income and revenues adequate for payment of the reasonable expense of operation and maintenance and for depreciation and replacement of said system; and


WHEREAS, the above-described costs and expenses of operating said system are increasing; and

WHEREAS, a rate and charge increase of twelve percent (12%) is sufficient to help defray these increasing costs and is not subject to review by the Public Service Commission.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana:

That it is advisable for the City of Polson to take affirmative steps to effectuate a twelve percent (12%) increasing water rates and connection charges. This proposed increase shall apply to residential and commercial rates and charges. A public hearing upon this Resolution shall be held to consider the proposed increase, after which a final decision shall be made within thirty (30) days.
