WHEREAS, The 1987 Montana Legislature passed H.B. 708 creating Heritage Day as a legal holiday, and;

WHEREAS, The Polson City Council passed Resolution 497 setting the holiday to be observed each year on the fourth Friday in November, and;

WHEREAS, S.B. 78 passed by the 1991 Montana Legislature establishing the third Monday in January as a state holiday in honor of Martin Luther King Jr. and eliminates Heritage Day as a state holiday all effective October 1, 1991.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Polson City Council that Polson City employees observe Heritage Day July 5, 1991.
