

RESOLUTION NO. 596

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A FEE FOR INSPECTION OF FENCES.

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to establish a reasonable fee for the inspection of fence construction by the City Building Inspector to determine compliance with the City Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a fee of \$25.00 would be a reasonable fee to be charged for the inspection of all fences 6 feet or under in height, and that for fences over the height of 6 feet, the sliding fee schedule presently in use for fence permits should be utilized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a fee for inspection of fences shall be established, as follows:

- 1. \$25.00 shall be charged for the inspection of all fences 6 feet or under in height;
- 2. For fences over the height of 6 feet, the sliding fee schedule presently in use for fence permits shall be utilized.
