

RESOLUTION NO. 618,

A RESOLUTION OF ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, the City of Polson has received a Petition for Annexation from Eugene Clairmont, pursuant to M.C.A. §7-2-4601; and

WHEREAS, the City of Polson finds that the Petition is signed by more than fifty (50%) of the owners of the territory to be annexed, which property is adjacent to the existing corporate boundary of the City of Polson, said property being described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land in the E1/2 SE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 9, Township 22 North, Range 20 West, M.P.M., Lake County, Montana, described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the SE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 9, T. 22 N., R. 20 W., M.P.M., which said corner is the center of the said Section 9; thence North 208.71 feet; thence West 208.71 feet; thence South 208.71 feet; thence East 208.71 feet to the point of beginning.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the corporate limits of the City of Polson, a municipal corporation, is hereby extended to include that property described above. The property is to be zoned R-1, and shall be in Voting Ward 3. The Clerk is directed to prepare a certified copy of this Resolution and file same in the office of the Clerk and Recorder of Lake County.
