

RESOLUTION NO. 641

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING TAMSCO MANUFACTURING, D/B/A TAMSCOUR A MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY TAX INCENTIVE

WHEREAS, The Montana legislature has provided for property tax incentives to encourage construction for new and expanding manufacturing industry (Section 15-24-1401, et seq. M.C.A.); and

WHEREAS, The City of Polson, by and through Resolution No. 637, has adopted a property tax incentive for qualifying manufacturing industries located within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, Tamsco Manufacturing is a qualified applicant as defined by §15-24-1401 M.C.A. and has applied for and requested the City of Polson to grant it a property tax incentive as above-described. The Applicant's proposed expansion including improvements to real property, equipment, modernized process and product to be produced at the facility are more particularly described as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Polson City Council of Polson, Lake County, Montana that Tamsco Manufacturing's Application for the property tax reduction under City of Polson Resolution No. 637 be approved for Tamsco Manufacturing's facility to be located upon approximately 10 acres located on City of Polson property on the west side of the City with the major business access off of Kerr Dam Road.

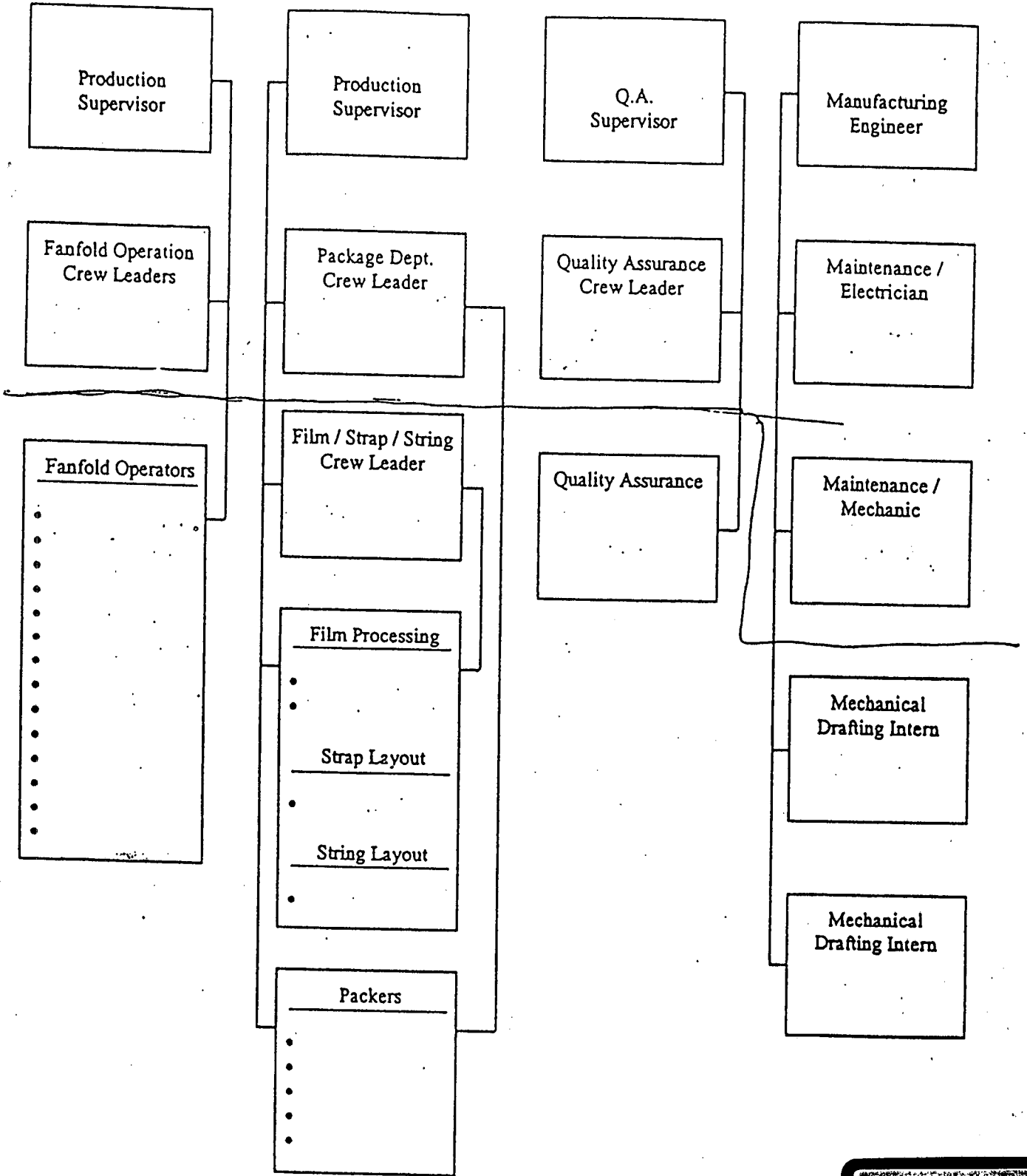

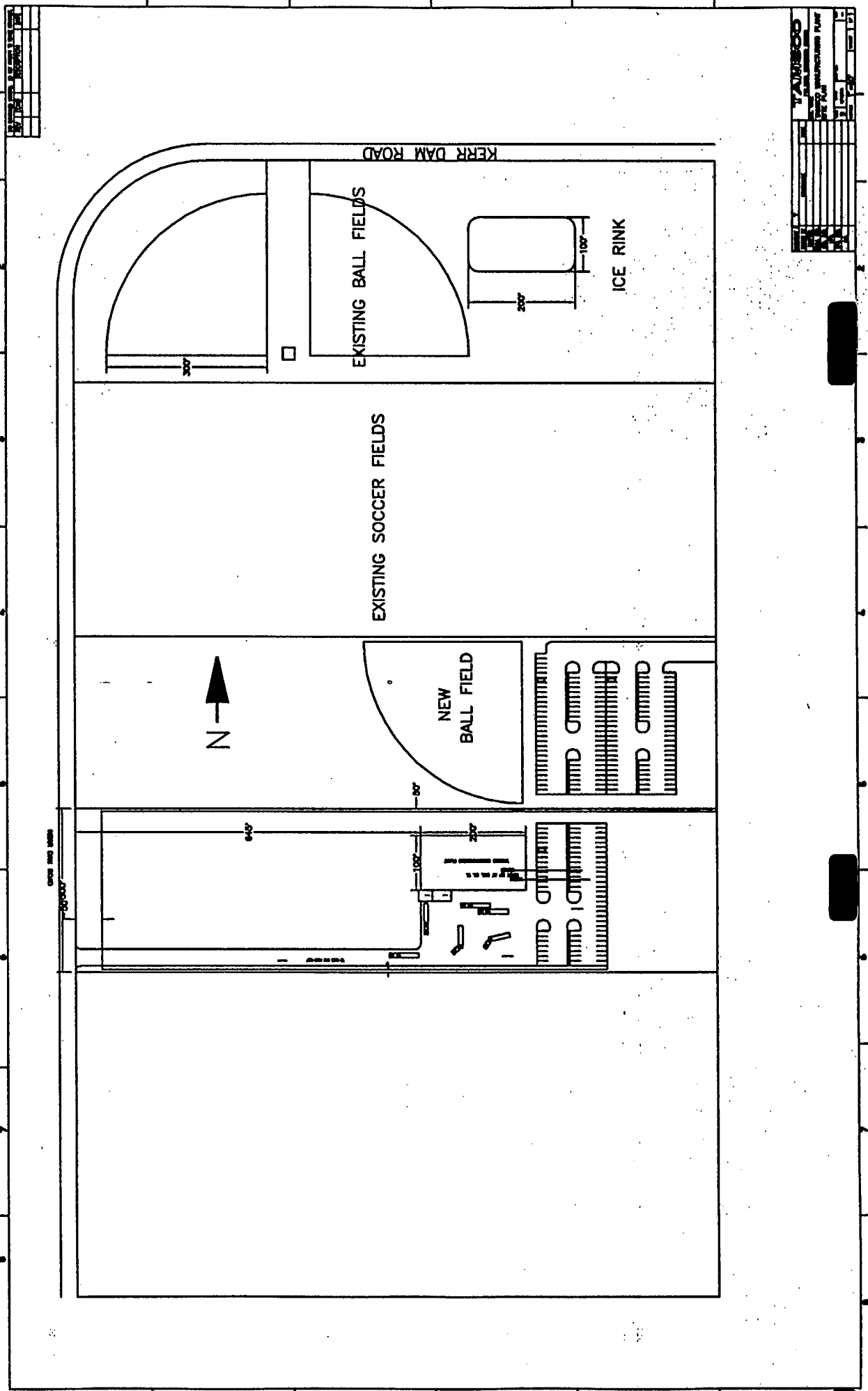

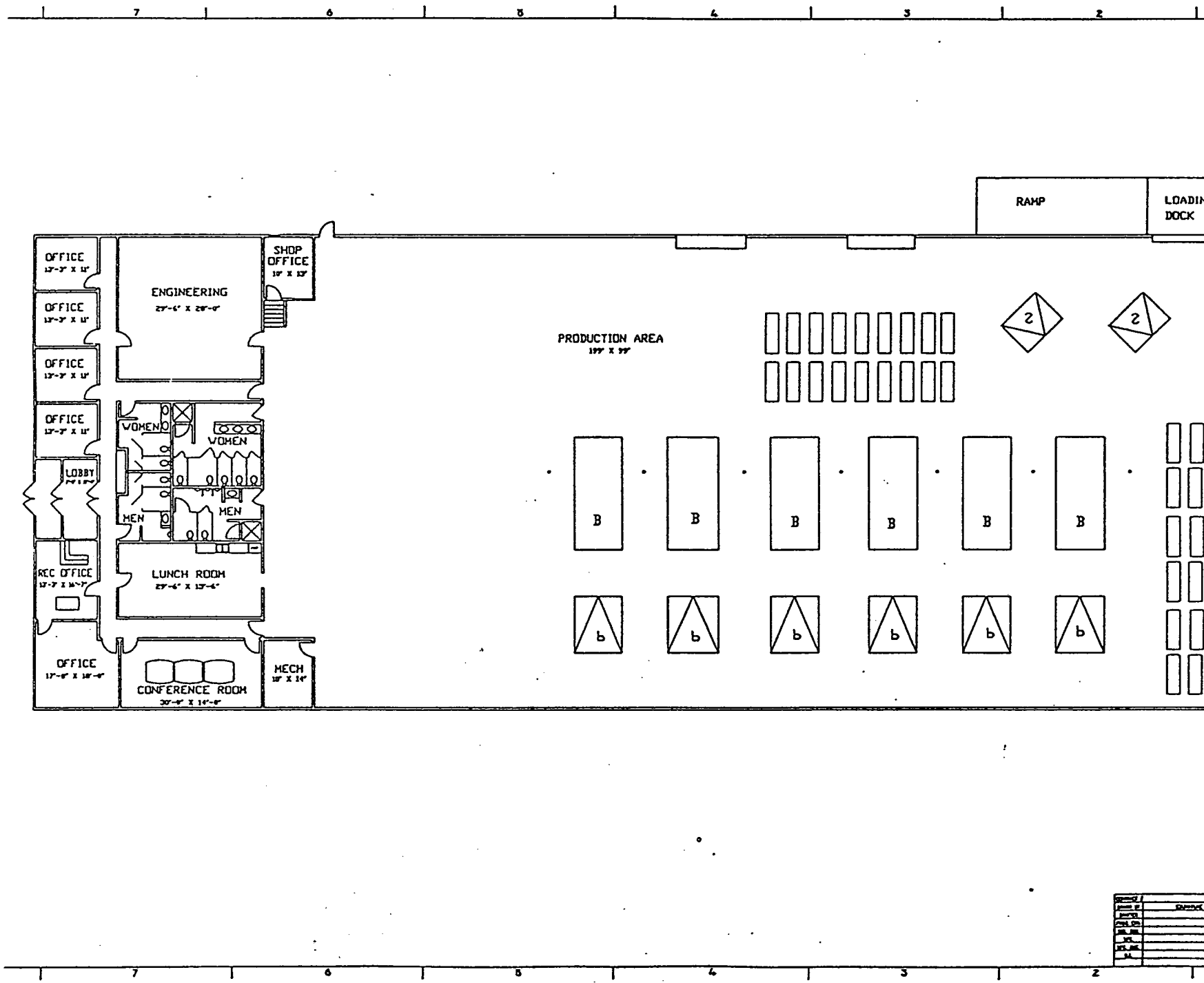
