

RESOLUTION # 776

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT REVISED RESIDENTIAL SEWER RATE

WHEREAS, the City of Polson has determined that the existing residential sewer rates do not adequately compensate the City for costs incurred in operation and upgrade of the sewage treatment plant of the City in terms of short term and long term maintenance, repair and replacement of the sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Polson has undertaken a thorough examination and review of the fee schedule and, in the course thereof, examined the fee schedules of similarly situated local governments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Polson has considered the proposed new fee schedule at a public hearing duly noticed and conducted in the City Council Chambers on April 5th, 1999, and considered the comments made by the public at such hearing. The sewer rate shall be:

Sewer Rate: First 5,000 gallons per month \$15.00
Each additional 1,000 gallons/month \$ 1.70


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the City Council, pursuant to authority vested in the Polson Municipal Codes section 4.06030(B), does hereby adopt the revised residential and commercial sewer rate as presented and considered at the public hearing in the amount above set forth. Said fees are effective as of the 15th day of April, 1999.


