

RESOLUTION NO. 800

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE FEDERAL HATCH ACT (5 USC 1501, et seq.; 5 CFR, Part 151)

WHEREAS, the City of Polson has, by other ordinance or resolution, provided for a contract to perform maintenance and work on the existing City sanitary sewer system; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Polson intends to fund the aforesaid sanitary sewer improvement in part through funds available from the Community Development Block Grant program; and,

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant program requires, as a precondition of disbursing funds to the City of Polson, that the said municipality adopt the terms of Title 5, United States Code, Section 1501, et seq., otherwise known as the Federal Hatch Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the City Council of the City of Polson hereby adopts the terms of Title 5, United States Code, Sections 1501, et seq., the Federal Hatch Act, and the City Clerk appointed as the Hatch Act Information Officer, responsible to disseminate the contents hereof and the Hatch Act by reference to all City employees by means of written communication and to monitor compliance with the terms hereof.
