

RESOLUTION NO. 814

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO ABANDON CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS PLATTED IN THE POLSON CITY CENTER ADDITION.

WHEREAS, the City of Polson plans to make improvements to that certain real property owned by the City of Polson and known commonly as O'Malley Park, and has determined that the streets and alleys therein are platted but have not been developed for use; and,

WHEREAS, the streets and alleys which the City intends to abandon are as follows:

10th Avenue East between 2nd Street East and 4th Street East.

3rd Street East between 11th Avenue East and Lot 31, Block 3 and Lot 19, Block 2, Polson City Center Addition.


Platted alley from 11th Avenue East through block 6 to Lot 31 and lot 20 of block 3, Polson City Center Addition.

Platted alley in Block 2 from Lots 25-26 to lots 13-38, Polson City Center Addition.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

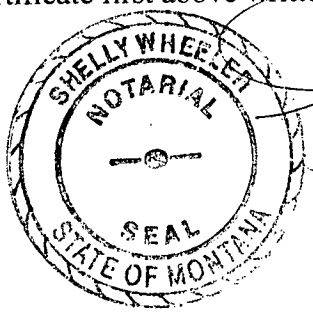


