RESOLUTION #839

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2002-2003.

WHEREAS, pursuant to MCA section 7-6-4021 the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana held a public hearing on the proposed budget on Monday, July 29, 2002 as required by law.

WHEREAS, pursuant to MCA section 7-6-4030 the City Council of the City of Polson has amended its preliminary budget after the public hearing with consideration of public comment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Polson City Council;

- 1) that the amended budget be approved and adopted, and that passage of this resolution authorizes appropriations to defray the expenses or liabilities for the 2002-2003 fiscal year in accordance with items set forth in the amended budget, and
- 2) that the Department of Revenue has provided the City of Polson with their certified taxable valuation pursuant to 15-10-202 MCA. The taxable valuations of \$5,639,113 for district 23P and \$380,549 for district 23PA were used to complete the form provided for determination of tax revenue and mill levy limitations under House Bill 124, which yielded 99.72 mills for district 23P and 23PA which are now combined into one district 23P, through Resolution #836, and
- 3) that the mill levies for fiscal year 2002-2003 be fixed and adopted at 99.72 mills for districts 23P and 23PA, now combined and known as one district 23P through Resolution #836, and
- 4) that pursuant to Municipal Budget Law contained in Title 7 Chapter 6, Part 40 of the Montana Code Annotated, as allowed by section 7-6-4031, the Mayor with the approval of the City Council is hereby authorized to transfer appropriations between items within the same fund.

The effective date of this resolution shall be July 1, 2002.
